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Policy on Player Releases and Transfers for Select and Rec Clubs

Recreational Clubs

I. Player Drops, Transfers, and Additions to Rosters

- Recreational Club registrars have the authority to drop, transfer, and add players (recreational only) to rosters using the new League One registration program.
- For organizations that are not using the League One registration software, you will still need to add or remove players from your roster and print out a new copy for your coach.

Select Clubs

II. Player Release (Drop)

- Anytime a player wishes to be released from his current team, the KYSA Player Release Form must be properly filled out and submitted to the state office for approval.
- Once approved, the state office will then go into the League One system, drop the player from the roster, and file the release form in the appropriate member organization file.
- The club registrar may then go into the League One system and print out a new roster for the team(s) involved.

III. Player Transfer between two clubs

- Anytime a player wishes to be transferred to another club, the KYSA Player Release Form must be properly filled out and submitted to the state office for approval. Parent and player signatures will be required for transfers between clubs.
- Once approved, the state office will then go into the League One system, transfer the player to the new team, and file the form in the appropriate member organization file.
- The club registrar may then go into the League One system and print out a new roster for the team(s) involved.
- Organizations not using the League One software will still need to follow the procedure above. However, once the form has been approved, a copy will be sent back to the releasing organization and the accepting organization, and they will be responsible for creating a new roster and submitting it to the state office. ***The Roster Change Form is no longer valid and a new roster must be produced and approved by a state registrar.***
- ***IMPORTANT: See the new policy on player transfers in our state rules.***

IV. Player Transfer within the same club

- Anytime a player wishes to transfer to another team in the same club, or from recreational to select or vice versa in the same club, a local club registrar may perform this transfer in the League One System.
- The club registrar may then go into the League One system and print out a new roster for the team(s) involved.
- The KYSA Player Release Form is not necessary for transfers within the same club for Organizations using the League One Program. The program will track those transfers.
- Only Organizations not using the League One software who have teams that wish to be eligible for State Open Cup competition will still need to follow the procedure in section III above, as it is the only way to track transfers for that competition.
